Each artist is limited to two pieces each with a maximum dimension of:

2D Artwork: 32" x 32" (32" in any direction)

3D Artwork: 16" x 16" (must be free standing)

2D Artworks MUST be delivered wired and ready to hang. Framed artworks preferred.

Minimum Price: \$75 (our goal is to raise maximum funds and we have limited space)

Rochester Contemporary Art Center (RoCo) will not take a commission on sales for this special fundraiser. Conditions of the exhibition are on Page 2.

CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITION AT ROCHESTER CONTEMPORARY ART CENTER

- Artworks left at Rochester Contemporary Art Center after September 30 will become the property of the Art Center.
- Any work sold will remain at the gallery for the duration of the exhibition.
- 2D Artworks must be delivered wired and ready to hang and 32" x 32" maximum.
- 3D Artworks must be 16" x 16" x 16" maximum and freestanding.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center reserves the right to photograph or reproduce artworks for educational purposes, press releases, catalogs, newsletters, or documentation of the exhibition.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center will present the work(s) as directed by the artist, as faithfully as possible and in a professional manner.
- If the artwork is damaged from transportation, or deterioration is noticed during the exhibition, the Art Center will notify the artist immediately. Rochester Contemporary Art Center will not attempt to repair damaged work without consulting the artist, unless safety to staff or the public warrants such action.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center provides replacement cost insurance on damaged or stolen work. Replacement cost refers only to material costs incurred in recreating the artwork. It does not refer to market or sales value.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center reserves the right to remove any work(s) from the exhibition.
